

*“Either you are with us or you are against us.”*

There is no difference in principle with Hitler’s *“Ein Reich, Ein Volk, Ein Führer.”* And the result?

Failing pension, school, and healthcare systems. Increasing illiteracy, poverty, crime, inflation, massive public debt. Loss of individual freedom, decreasing private security, increasing societal disorder, unemployment. Inability to solve even one basic societal problem. Tens of thousands of people killed in war, vast amounts of property destroyed. Doesn’t a 500 pound bomb cause “mass destruction”? Is it not a terrorist weapon? Ask someone who has been a victim of one. Is this not a crime against humanity?

To solve our problems we must use the concept of “discovery” as described by the great Hungarian physicist Albert Szent-Györgyi von Nagryapolt:

*“Discovery consists in seeing what everyone else has seen and thinking what no one else has thought.”*

*Cowardly New World* describes the cause of our societal problems. And provides the concept and outline for the creation of a rational and durable societal structure. That will allow us to first solve our societal problems. And *then* the problems of global warming.

The choice is up to individual thinking beings. To adopt a workable societal system very soon and *without causing disruption in society*. Or for Homo Sapiens to go into the dustbin of history.

Societal systems based on coercion can not cope with the results of global warming.

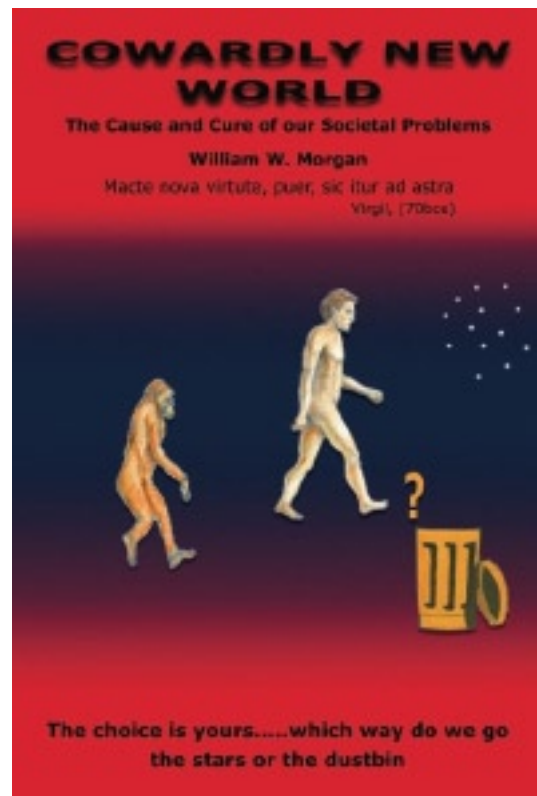
